Practical modalities Duration: +/- 3 hours Depending on the number of people, tables should be placed separately to sit 4

Depending on the number of people, tables should be placed separately to sit 4 people around each table or group of tables 1 board to display the results A pair of scissors, writing material

Brief description of the text that is going to be worked upon within the final task Establishing the agenda with the steps and aims for this session Audience is divided in groups depending on their language Task starts Explanation of the approach Reflective analysis and turn of questions

Precision regarding theoretical references underlying the activity (natural method for reading and writing / Freinet's methodology / adult teaching)

III. Self-determination evidence

This action is contingent upon the participants' opinion, their reality and their questioning. This way, by being directly involved, they make sense of their learning experience whilst feeling motivated. They quickly recognize and establish a link with their everyday life and face their learning experience with the viewpoint and dynamics of a researcher.
